

The Divine Goodness

To the children of Savior of the World and to Louisa their devoted mother who labors for them with a love that is both precious and privileged;

*to all of Louisa's coworkers and family members who accept their very serious responsibility to live and conduct themselves every day as a true family for the children;

*to all of you who help the children of the Savior of the World Family and who therefore constitute the necessary backbone of this now flourishing family;

*in a word, to all of you who are opening your

hearts to Jesus:

I would like to tell you the story of Saint Aloysius.

St. Aloysius was 18 years old when he decided to give up any claim he had to property, money or possessions. At that time he perceived that Jesus wanted him to be a priest.

Even in his childhood the Saint was a bit sickly. His problem was the kidney. Because he often had to rest, he found time to pray. He never wasted time with daydreams. Prayer also gave his heart and his will strength and firmness. This was very im-

portant because his father was addicted to gambling. An addiction like gambling can destroy a person's will power, because once they begin to gamble on a regular basis, they gamble more and more and they cannot stop to do other things. This means that a man like the father of Aloysius begins to neglect his wife and his children, so that they begin to think that this man has no love in his heart for other people. This man soon looks like he loves only gambling for money, nothing else.

This was the case with the father of Aloysius.

When Aloysius decided to give up all material things and become a priest, his father was shocked and in fact was very angry. Aloysius knew he was doing the right thing, so the religious community called the Jesuits accepted him. Aloysius began his preparation for the priesthood: he studied for many hours, and prayed for many hours.

Aloysius also played football. One time another student said to Aloysius, "Here you are playing football! Should you not be in your room praying?" Aloysius answered him with a very

intelligent answer: "At the present moment God wants me to be playing football. That means that if I went to my room and prayed I would be disobeying God and would be showing disrespect for God. It is always better to do what God wants; and at this moment God wants me to play football."

When Aloysius was 23 years old, a terrible famine spread in his region of Italy. This means that many people were getting sick from hunger, and the sickness was killing many people. Aloysius himself had the fever but he chose to love and take care of the other sick people, morning, noon and night. Aloysius did not stop to rest. As I said, he was only 23 years old.

Before he died Aloysius sent a letter to his mother. It is a very tender and loving letter. It shows how much he respected his mother. Here is the letter:

"It is my earnest prayer, most noble lady, that you may enjoy the grace of the Holy Spirit and his eternal consolation.
When your letter reached me I was still in

this region of death. But, my dear mother, we should at times long for heaven where we may praise the eternal God in the land of the living. I had lately hoped indeed that I would have completed this journey before now. If charity consists, as Saint Paul says, in weeping with those who mourn and rejoicing with those who rejoice, then you should derive immense joy, most noble mother, from the fact that God in his love and kindness for you is bestowing on me the one true joy and the assurance that I shall be free from the fear of ever losing it.

"I confess, most noble lady, that when I consider the divine goodness which is as deep as the sea and as boundless, my mind seems to be lost and overwhelmed in its immensity. In return for how short and trifling a service does God summon me to eternal rest? How negligently have I sought the infinite joys of heaven to which he invites me! How remiss have I been in shedding those tears for which he is assuring me an eternal reward!

"Consider again and again, most noble lady,

this infinite mercy of
God and be careful never to make little of it, as
you undoubtedly would if
you were to lament as
though he were dead for
one who is living in the
sight of God. There he
will give you the help of
his intercession much
more effectively than
when he was still in this
life.

"Our separation will not be of long duration: we shall meet again in heaven. United in the assurance of our salvation, we shall together enjoy eternal happiness praising God with all the energy of our souls and extolling his mercy forever as we share in the joys of eternity.

"He takes from us that life which he gave us for a time for no other purpose than to restore it to us freed of all care and anxiety and to endow us with those benefits which have been the object of our hopes.

"I have said all this in pursuance of my earnest hope that you, most noble lady, and all my family will regard my death as a joyful gift of God and they you will give me your maternal blessing as I cross this sea towards that shore where all my hopes are

centered. I have said all this the more readily because there is no other way in which I can express to you so clearly the love and filial reverence which I owe to you, my mother."

You can see from this letter that Saint Aloysius had full confidence in the power of Jesus Christ to give us strength in our moments of suffering and hunger. You can see that this young Saint, 23 years of age, knew the love and the power of Jesus to bring us through the darkness of death into the light of heaven. You can see that Aloysius firmly believed that the suffering of this world has a purpose: to remind us of the joy that God wishes to give us after we die, the eternal joy of heaven.

I am praying for all of you: that all of you be patient and understanding with each other. I pray that whenever there is a difficulty or a misunderstanding that you forgive each other and pray for each other with the same love and confidence that Saint Aloysius showed his mother before he died.
